**Preamble**

WHEREAS, it is expedient further to amend the Balochistan Sea Fisheries Ordinance, 1971 in the manner hereinafter appearing:

It is hereby enacted as follows:

**Short title and commencement.**

(2)

2. (1) This Act may be called the Balochistan Sea Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 2014.

It shall come into force at once.

**Amendment of Section 9, Ordinance No. IX Of 1971.**

3. In the Balochistan Sea Fisheries Ordinance, 1971 (Ordinance No. IX of 1971), hereinafter referred as the said Act, in Section 9, for the second proviso the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“ Provided further that fishing craft/trawler operating with the banned fishing gear/net or without valid fishing license shall also be liable to confiscation along with the banned fishing gear/net; and on conviction the banned fishing gear/net shall be destroyed in the presence of a Magistrate, while the fishing craft/trawler shall be auctioned through wide publicity in leading newspapers”.

**Omission of Section 10, Ordinance No. IX of 1971.**

4. In the above said Act, Section 10 shall be omitted.
